2020 Software Testing Contest at UT Dallas

The 2020 Contest on Software Testing for the Dallas Fort-Worth Metropolitan area was held at the University of Texas at Dallas on February 6th. This event was co-sponsored by the Computer Science Department at UT Dallas and the Dallas Chapter of IEEE Reliability Society. A tutorial on software testing was also presented. Through this contest and tutorial, we brought real-world testing and tool experience to the participants and provided excellent opportunities for them to practice their learned testing techniques to address industry testing challenges.

There were over 70 contestants from local universities and high schools. They were divided into two groups: college group and high school group. The contest was individual based. Each contestant was required to design test cases with specific input values based on the given source code and specification to test two Java programs. The quality of test cases was measured by the code coverage and mutation score.

The first place of each group received a cash prize of \$1,000 USD, followed by the second for \$500 USD, the third place for \$250, and five fourth places each received a present.
